Resolution of Endorsement

WHEREAS, we believe that the Make America Great Again platform and programs, presented by former US President Donald J. Trump, Senator JD Vance and the Republican Party, properly reflect and build upon the traditional values of the Western Civilization, such as freedom, entrepreneurship, democracy and peace, which we deem dear; and

WHEREAS, our conservative convictions oblige us to endorse candidates that will fight for an enduring moral order, protect American traditions and values, and exercise prudence in all decisions for the betterment of America; and

WHEREAS, President Trump's track record gives us confidence in his abilities going forward; and

WHEREAS, in contrast, the declarations and intents presented by the Democrat Party candidates Vice-President Kamala Harris and Governor Tim Waltz promote division, interests of splinter groups, exploit differences among the members of the American society and are devoid of the substance that concerns most Americans, including Polish Americans; and

WHEREAS, we believe that the intents of the Democrat Party aim at undermining the US Constitution and introducing profound changes in our political system, based on totalitarian and Marxist ideology and patterns, thereby constituting a grave threat not only to democracy, but to the whole Western Civilization; and

WHEREAS, the current Administration of President Joe Biden, with full support of Vice-President Kamala Harris, undertook a number of actions which we deem anti-American, anti-freedom, and anti-Polish, such as:

- Weakening the protection of the southern border of the US, inviting the invasion of illegal immigrants, including criminals from around the world, which in turn created chaos in our country's financial system, public safety, health care and the labor market; presidential candidate Kamala Harris, acting as

current Vice-President and the “Border Czar”, has had a major role in this process, destructive for our country; Blocking the construction of the Keystone XL gas pipeline, which almost immediately triggered economic decline of our country through rising energy costs;

- Lifting the sanctions on companies involved in the construction of the Nord Stream gas pipeline from Russia to Germany, which were introduced by former President Trump, thus handing over Central Europe to the political and economic domination of the German-Russian alliance and enabling Putin's Russia to quickly accumulate capital, which facilitated the war against Ukraine;
- Lifting financial sanctions on universities that engage in censorship practices and block freedom of speech on campuses, which were enacted during the former President Donald Trump's presidency;
- Ordering a chaotic, tragic withdrawal of American troops from Afghanistan, which projected around the world the image of US military weakness and encouraged our enemies to engage in military conflicts;
- Weaponizing and corrupting the US justice system, politicizing federal agencies, abusing them to fight political opponents by filing baseless law suits with intent of harassment, which results in erosion of trust in our system by Americans.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the New Jersey Division of the Polish American Congress:

1. Endorses Donald J. Trump for US President, and the whole Republican Team for US Senate and Congress; and
2. Appeals to all Americans, particularly Polish Americans, to make sure to fulfill their citizen's duty by voting in the upcoming elections, taking the above into careful consideration.
